CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Basingstoke and Deane (Parishes) Order 1985

Made .....13th February 1985

Coming into Operation -

for the purposes described

in article 2(1) ..... 14th February 1985

for all other purposes ..... 1st April 1985

Whereas the Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council, acting pursuant to section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a), has made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals about parishes in the borough:

And whereas in consequence of those recommendations the Commission has seen fit, pursuant to sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, to make proposals to the Secretary of State:

And whereas more than six weeks has elapsed since those proposals were made:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to those proposals with a modification:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) and (5) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:-

Title and commencement

1. - This order may be cited as the Basingstoke and Deane (Parishes) Order 1985.

2. - (1) 14th February 1985 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the 1976 Regulations.

(2) For all other purposes, this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.

### Interpretation

3. - (1) In this order -

"the borough council" means the Basingstoke and Deane borough council;

"borough ward" means a ward of the borough of Basingstoke and Deane;

"the boundary maps" means the 24 maps (duly numbered for reference) which are issued by the Department of the Environment as "Maps of the Basingstoke and Deane (Parishes) Order 1985;

"county electoral division" means an electoral division of the county of Hampshire;

"new parish" means a parish created by article 4 of this order;

"new parish council" means a parish council constituted by article 8 of this order; and

"the 1976 Regulations" means the Local Government Areas Changes Regulations 1976 (a) .

### Creation of new parishes

4. There shall be created three further parishes in the borough of Basingstoke and Deane, to be named -

Ashford Hill with Headley  
Chineham  
Hannington

---

(a) S.I. 1976/246, as amended by S.I. 1978/247.

Each such parish shall -

- (a) consist of the areas mentioned in relation to it in column (2) of Schedule 1 hereto, which areas are marked as indicated in column (3) on the boundary maps mentioned in column (4);
- (b) form part of the relevant borough ward shown in column (5), and of the relevant county electoral division shown in column (6); and
- (c) be comprised in the Basingstoke petty sessional division, and in the Hampshire North East coroner's district.

Other transfers between parishes

5. Each area of a parish named in column (1) of Schedule 2 hereto marked as indicated in column (2) on the boundary map mentioned in column (3) shall be transferred to the relevant parish shown in column (4). Where there is mentioned in relation to any area -

- (a) a parish ward in column (5);
- (b) a borough ward in column (6);
- (c) a county electoral division in column (7); or
- (d) a petty sessional division in column (8) -

that area shall also be transferred to that ward or division.

Transfers from unparished area to parishes

6. The parts of the area of the former municipal borough of Basingstoke marked C1, C2 and C3 on boundary map 13 shall be transferred -

- (a) in the case of the areas marked C1 and C2 to the parish of Cliddesdon, and in the case of the area marked C3, to the parish of Winslade;
- (b) to the Upton Grey borough ward; and
- (c) to the Candovers county electoral division.

Areas ceasing to form part of any parish

7. Each area marked as indicated in column (1) of Schedule 3 hereto on the relevant boundary map shown in column (2) shall -

- (a) cease to form part of the relevant parish shown in column (3); and
- (b) form part of the relevant borough ward and county electoral division shown in columns (4) and (5) respectively.

New parish councils

8. (1) There shall be a parish council for each new parish.
- (2) There shall be 9 parish councillors for the new parish of Chineham, and 5 for the new parish of Hannington.
- (3) The new parish of Ashford Hill with Headley shall be divided into two parish wards of Ashford Hill and Headley, as shown by broken red lines on boundary map 24. The two wards shall be represented by 3 and 4 parish councillors respectively.
- (4) Any person who is in office immediately prior to 1st April 1985 as a parish councillor of a parish or parish ward mentioned in the first column below, and who is resident in the relevant new parish or new parish ward shown in the second column, shall cease to hold that office on that date, but shall be a councillor of the relevant new parish or new parish ward until the fourth day after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 1987.

- (5) Parish councillors for the parish of Kingsclere in office immediately prior to 1st April 1985 shall retire, and as from that day the number of councillors for that parish shall be reduced from 11 to 9. That parish shall also cease to be warded.
- (6) Elections of additional parish councillors for the new parishes and of new councillors for the parish of Kingsclere (as altered by this order) shall be held on such day before 1st April 1985 as the returning officer shall appoint. The persons elected shall come into office on 1st April 1985, and shall retire on the fourth day after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 1987.
- (7) The annual meeting of each new parish council for 1985 shall be held in April 1985, and shall be convened by the proper officer of the borough council.
- (8) The first assembly of the parish meeting for any new parish shall be convened by the proper officer of the borough council. At any such first assembly held before the annual meeting of the parish council of the parish, the parish meeting may appoint a person to take the chair, and that person shall have, for the purposes of that meeting, the powers and authority of the chairman.

Expenses of new parish councils

9. (1) In the year beginning on 1st April 1985, the borough council shall pay by way of grant to each council of a new parish a sum equivalent to the product of a rate levy in that parish of 2p. in the pound.
- (2) In the case of the new parish of Chineham, the borough council shall levy rates therein and make a further payment to the council of that parish as if that parish council had issued a precept requiring the payment of a sum equal to the product of 1.5p. in the pound, calculated on the total rateable value of the parish as set out in the valuation list on 1st April 1985.

Statutory definitions of areas

10. For the purpose of regulation 40 of the 1976 Regulations, any reference to the area of the former borough of Basingstoke shall -

- (a) exclude the areas mentioned in article 6; and
- (b) be construed as including the areas mentioned in article 7.

Local Acts, orders and byelaws

11. Regulation 41 (Local Acts, orders and byelaws) of the 1976 Regulations shall apply to the area of the former borough of Basingstoke as if it were a relevant area within the meaning of regulation 41(2). For the purposes of any provision in force to which that regulation applies, that area shall exclude the areas mentioned in article 6 and include those mentioned in article 7.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order.)

This order affects parishes in the borough of Basingstoke and Deane by -

(a) creating three new parishes to be called -

Ashford Hill with Headley  
Chineham  
Hannington;

(b) transferring land between other parishes; and

(c) transferring land between the unparished area of the former municipal borough of Basingstoke and certain parishes.

The map forming part of this note (page 14) gives a general guide to the areas affected by this order as from 1st April 1985.

Prints of the detailed boundary maps, which form part of the order and are referred to in article 3, may be inspected at the offices of the borough council, and may be purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB.

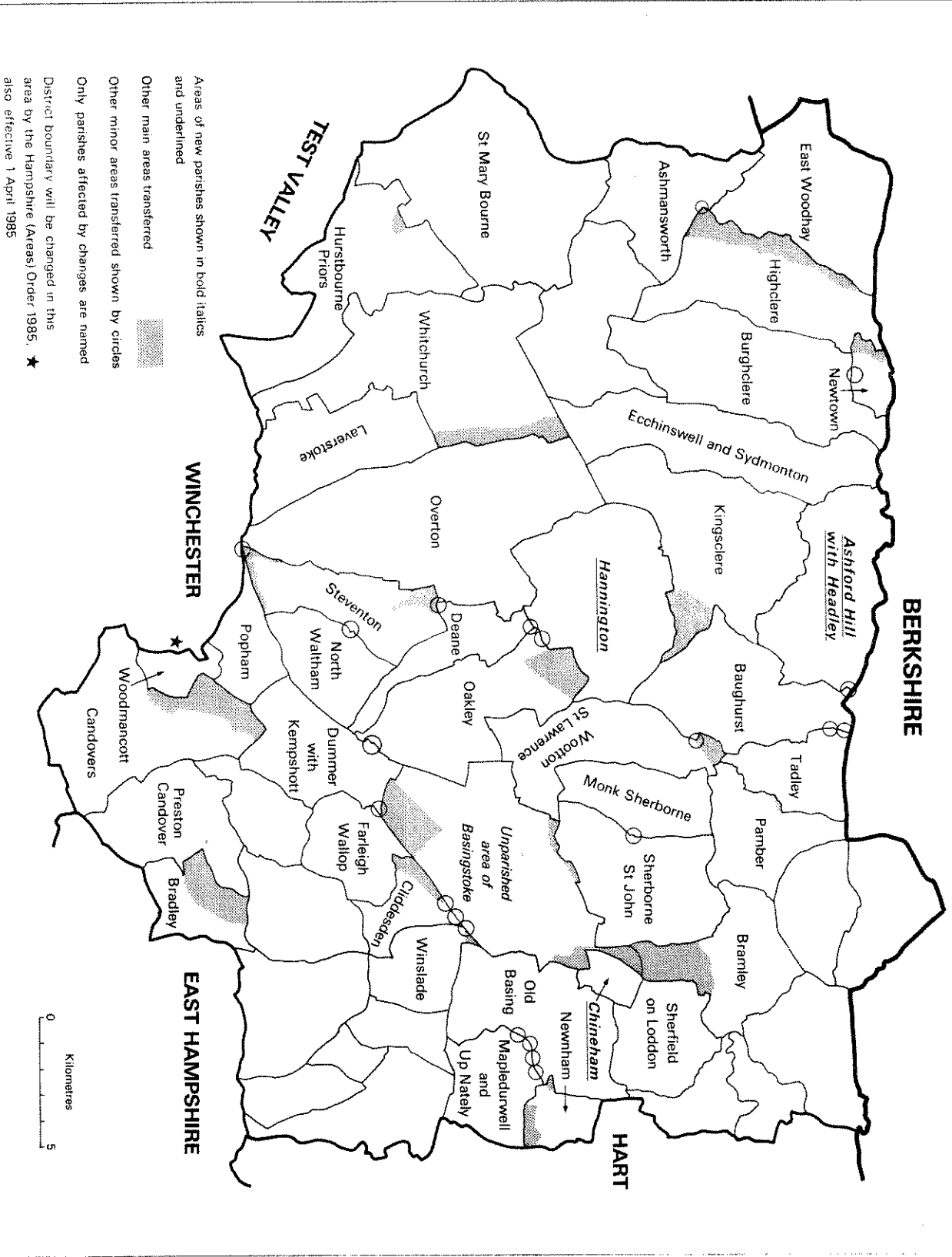
The approximate area and population of the new parishes will be -

Chineham	225	2900
Hannington	2,320	360

The order establishes a parish council for each new parish, and provides for fresh elections in the parish of Kingsclere. Consequential changes to local government areas are made.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976, mentioned in article 3, contain further provisions about the effect and implementation of orders such as the present one.
